I, _____, do by these presents, make, constitute and appoint the CAMP DIRECTOR, his/her agent, as my true and lawful attorney to act for me and in my name, place and stead; and to do any, every and all acts and exercise any, every and all powers that I might or could do in giving consent to emergency medical treatment for myself that he shall deem proper or advisable to do or exercise on my behalf.

This Power of Attorney and appointment of the CAMP DIRECTOR as my attorney-in-fact for the limited purpose of consenting to emergency medical treatment for the above-named person shall not terminate on my physical or mental disability subsequent to the date of execution hereof.

IT IS MY INTENTION BY EXECUTION OF THIS DOCUMENT TO COVENANT NOT TO SUE BRIDGEPORT CAMP & CONFERENCE CENTER, AND TO RELEASE BCCC, THE STAFF, THE NORTH TEXAS CONFERENCE OF THE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, AND ALL OTHERS ACTING FOR OR ON BEHALF OF BRIDGEPORT CAMP FROM ALL LIABILITY WHATSOEVER, FOR PERSONAL INJURY, OR INJURIES TO PROPERTY, REAL OR PERSONAL, CAUSED BY, OR ARISING OUT OF CAMPING AND OTHER ACTIVITIES SPONSORED BY BCCC.

2020 Code of Conduct

The following acts constitute "Improper Conduct" that will not be permitted at any event sponsored by the North Texas Conference, and could result in dismissal of any staff involved.

- Verbal abuse that humiliates, degrades or threatens any guest or employee participating in an event sponsored by the North Texas Conference
- Use of social media that puts our facility, staff, or participants in a negative light (Including, but not limited to Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.)
- Physical abuse such as striking, spanking or slapping
- Mental abuse
- Romantic involvement with any participant or employee
- Invading the privacy or a participant by watching a participant bathe or change clothes
- Discussing sexual experiences with a participant or encouraging participant to discuss his or her sexual experiences
- Counseling a participant in private (all counseling is to be done in the presence of others)
- Touching a participant in any manner, that goes beyond traditional displays of friendship normally seen in public and that could result in sexual stimulation including, but not limited to, prolonged embracing, kissing, or fondling
- Exposing genitals, any part of the body that should be clothed, and in the case of women, breasts, to a participant or employee
- The use of alcohol, tobacco, electronic cigarettes (or any other electronic vaporizing device), or drugs
- The carrying or discharging of firearms
- And, any violation of the Texas Penal Code

By signing this document, I also agree to the following statements

- I understand that pictures and videos are taken at camp and posted to the BCCC website. I hereby give permission for the use of such pictures and videos of my camper for the promotion of camp.
- I will be held financially responsible for any damages to facilities caused by my camper.
- I hereby affirm that I understand the risks of camping and recreational activities at BCCC.
- I understand that the terms herein are contractual and not a mere recital.
- I have signed this document as my own free act and in consideration of the agreement by BCCC to accept me for participation in a 2020 camp session.
