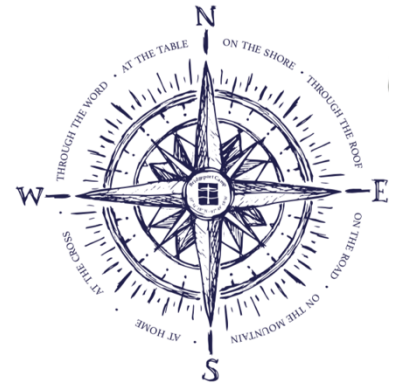


Thank you for registering for Camp Bible!

Check-in

Camp will be finished at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, September 23. **Parents and families are invited to join us for the closing worship that begins at 10:00 a.m. at the cross.** Campers will all work on an element of worship during their rotations on Saturday in order to lead Sunday's service. We hope you will join us for Sunday morning worship at Bridgeport Camp!

Medical

All Campers must bring a completed medical information when registering.

Keep medicine the bare minimum! **Please have the medication in the original container in a zip-lock bag with your child's name on the bag and the instructions written down inside it.** Put your medication where you can access it and bring it with you to check-in to give the nurse. Even over-the-counter medicine must be turned in to the nurse. If your child is carpooling with another adult, please give the medications to the adult who is bringing your child and have that adult check in medicine at registration.
